

Summary of the documents for the member meeting Feb 22



Points of information is the points where the student union Linnestudenterna inform about important documents and investigations which are relevant for our members. This is a good chance to ask questions if you have them, but also tell us your opinion. The members then approve the chairman's request to move on with the meeting when the members have been properly informed.

Report from the Office is written by the administrative boss of Linnestudenterna, Helen Nilsson. She is the boss of the staff, the employed but not the elected, at Linnestudenterna. In the Report from the Office you can read about what has happened at Linnestudenterna since the last member meeting and how we work for our members. On February 7 Linnestudenterna had 5808 members of the budgeted 7000 members. We hosted the Welcome Fair in Växjö to welcome new students. 55 companies and associations were there and the fair had over 1000 visitors.

The Message List is a list of all the meetings that the members of the student union presidium have been to since the last member meeting. Among other things, there have been many meetings with Växjö and Kalmar Municipality, meetings in boards and faculties at LNU and meetings with many of the student associations for various reasons. Guidelines for financial support for student associations. The board of the student union has put together guidelines for student associations to use when they apply for financial support from the student union. When a student association applies for financial support from the student union it is for specific projects or events that benefit students at LNU. The point of these guidelines is to make it easier for student associations when they apply so that they know what is asked of them when they write their application and during the rest of the process.

Decision points: The member meeting will be making decisions about these subjects. The board of the student union has prepared suggestions for decisions and these suggestions are found in the documents for this meeting. The student union board this year consists of 6 board members who all study full time in Växjö and Kalmar and also the student union presidium that consists of 4 students who have taken time off from studies to work full time at the student union. The presidium is a part of the board. It is up to the members to come to decisions about the subjects discussed at the meeting.

Deciding the size of the student union board. For next year it needs to be decided how big the board of the student union will be. The suggestion from the board this year is to still have 13 people on the board, the same number as this year.

Deciding the posts within the student union board and location of the board members: This point is to decide responsibilities for the different members of the student union board and in what town they will be working next year. The responsibilities are divided between Växjö and Kalmar. The suggestion from the board for this year is to mostly keep the structure as it is but to change the wording of some of the titles. The only other difference is that the board members who are responsible for connections to the world outside of the university also will have the connection to the distance students as a part of their job.

To approve the organization plan of Linnestudenterna. The student union board has, with this organization plan, tried to describe how the student union Linnestudenterna works. The idea is to easily be able to see what the relationship is between the member meeting and the student union board and also between the student union and its members and the student associations. It is up to the members to decide whether or not this plan reflects reality.
