Your digital membership card

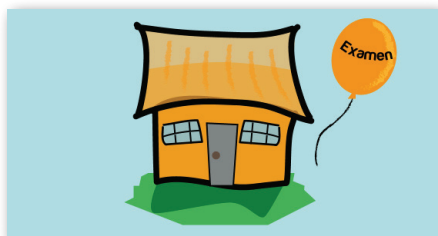
